SUBJECT: **The San Jose/Santa Clara Water Pollution Control Plant Master Plan**
– Status Report

DISCUSSION: The San Jose/Santa Clara Water Pollution Control Plant (Plant), co-owned by the cities of San Jose and Santa Clara, treats approximately 110 million gallons a day of wastewater from these and six other Santa Clara County cities for discharge to the South Bay and for local reuse. San Jose's Environmental Services Department, as operator of the Plant, initiated a three-year Master Plan last year. John Stufflebean, Department Director, will make a presentation about the Master Plan process and the infrastructure issues the Master Plan is intended to address.

The Master Plan will be a 30-year plan integrating the facilities, operations, and land uses of the Plant and its lands, incorporating the principles of sustainability with the goals of continued regulatory compliance, protecting and restoring habitat, increasing worker and community safety, being a "good neighbor", and providing public value and economic opportunities. The Master Plan will evaluate opportunities to maximize the beneficial uses of biosolids and water reuse, as well as the land uses of the Plant's 2,600 acres.
