The primary purpose of the Tentative Orders is to 1) revise due dates for tasks related to soil and groundwater investigation and cleanup that were required under the previous Water Board order for SLAC (Order No. R2-2009-0022) and 2) prescribe maximum liability should the discharger violate the tasks or the task due dates.

Consideration of the Tentative Orders is scheduled for the October 14th, 2009 Water Board meeting to be held at the Elihu M. Harris State Building, First Floor Auditorium, 1515 Clay Street, Oakland, California, beginning at 9:00am.
