Acceptance of Conditional Early Settlement Offer for Mandatory Minimum Penalties

On the dates shown below, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) issued a Conditional Offer to Participate in the Water Board's Expedited Payment Program for Effluent or Reporting Violations (Expedited Payment Program) in an effort to resolve outstanding liability for violations that are subject to a mandatory minimum penalty of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars each pursuant to subdivisions (h) and (i) of the California Water Code section 13385. The following facilities have accepted the Regional Water Board's Offer and agreed to waive their right to a hearing and pay a mandatory minimum penalty.
