**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR
ISSUANCE OF NPDES PERMIT**

The above party has filed an application for permit re-issuance under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. Regional Water Board staff has prepared a tentative permit containing specific provisions in accordance with the federal Clean Water Act and the California Water Quality Control Act.

Bay Ship & Yacht owns and operates a ship repair and maintenance yard off Main Street in Alameda adjacent to the Oakland Inner Harbor. The facilities include a floating dry dock used for repairing and maintaining vessels. When water is pumped from the dry dock ballast tanks, the dry dock rises and the vessel in the dry dock is raised out of the water. When the ballast tanks are flooded, the dry dock lowers and the vessel is released.

There will be a public hearing to receive oral testimony and to consider adoption of the tentative permit at a meeting to commence at the time and location below:

The last date for written comments is 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 15, 2010. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Derek Whitworth**. Persons wishing to file written comments on, or objections to, the tentative permit or other aspects of this matter must do so by this date so such comments may be considered. No written comments will be accepted or responded to in writing after that date. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views orally at the public hearing.

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Regional Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections raised before the Regional Water Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence delivered to the Regional Water Board.
