**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
FOR  
AMENDMENT OF DISCHARGE PERMITS**

Facilities that discharge wastewaters to surface waters within the San Francisco Bay Region operate pursuant to National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits containing limitations and provisions in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act and the California Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff has prepared a tentative order to amend most of these permits.

The amendment applies consistent standard requirements across the permits by updating and consolidating existing requirements into one document that reflects current requirements. For those permits that require dioxin and furan monitoring and reporting, it also provides new directions for calculations involving dioxins and furans.

The Regional Water Board intends to consider adopting the tentative order during a meeting to commence at the time and location as follows:

**The deadline for comments is 5:00 p.m. on December 21, 2009.** Comments must be sent to the **attention of Bill Johnson**. Persons wishing to file written comments on or objections to the tentative order or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered. No written comments will be accepted or responded to in writing if received after the deadline.

Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing on this matter. The Regional Water Board will hear oral testimony but will not accept written comments after the deadline noted above.

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Regional Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under California Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections raised before the Regional Water Board at the hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence delivered to the Regional Water Board.

The tentative order and supporting documents, including comments received, may be inspected and copied at the Regional Water Board office.
