forth in the attached Hearing Procedure. At the meeting, the Regional Water Board may impose an administrative civil liability in the amount proposed or for a different amount, decline to seek civil liability, or refer the case to the Attorney General for judicial enforcement.

- 2. You can waive your right to the 90-day hearing requirement in order to engage in settlement discussions.
- 3. You can waive the right to a hearing to contest the allegations contained in the Complaint by completing the waiver attached to the Complaint.

If you waive your hearing rights, you must mail and fax a copy of the signed waiver by the time and date specified below to the attention of Sandia Potter of the Advisory Team with a copy to Laurent Meillier of the Prosecution Team. Both faxes should be sent to (510) 622-2460.

The deadline for submittal of written comments and evidence to the Complaint and waiver is **November 16, 2009**, at 5 p.m. The deadline for submittal of a Supplemental Environmental Project proposal(s) is **November 30, 2009**, at 5 p.m.
