Treatment Plant, Tiburon, Marin County – Rescission of NPDES

Permit

CHRONOLOGY: December 2006 – Board reissues NPDES permit

DISCUSSION: The attached Tentative Order would rescind the NPDES Permit for

Seafirth Estates Company. Seafirth used to discharge treated

wastewater from about 30 homes to Central San Francisco Bay via a submerged diffuser off the north side of the Tiburon Peninsula. To eliminate this discharge, Seafirth installed two pump stations in September 2009 to transfer sewage to a nearby wastewater treatment plant in Tiburon. Because Seafirth's wastewater treatment plant is no longer in commission, it no longer needs the permit. Therefore, it is

appropriate to rescind the permit.

We received no comments on the Tentative Order and expect this

matter to be uncontested.
