SUBJECT: East Brother Light Station, Inc., East Brother Light Station, East

Brother Island off of Point Richmond, Contra Costa County – Adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements for On-site Disposal and

Rescission of NPDES permit.

CHRONOLOGY: September 2004—NPDES Permit Reissued

DISCUSSION: The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) would establish Waste

Discharge Requirements for the discharge of 50 to 100 gallons a day of domestic wastewater to subsurface soil on East Brother Island. The Tentative Order would also rescind the NPDES permit for East Brother Light Station because the permit would no longer be needed once

discharge to the onsite subsurface system commences.

East Brother Light Station, Inc., leases East Brother Island from the United States Coast Guard at no cost. It generates funds to maintain East Brother Light Station, a registered historic landmark, by operating a bed and breakfast in the former keeper's quarters. The domestic wastewater comes from cooking, dishwashing, showering, and flushing toilets. Wastewater is, and will continue to be, treated and disinfected

before discharge.

We received no comments on the draft order we circulated for public review, and expect this item to remain uncontested. The Revised Tentative Order reflects revisions we made to the draft order. The main revision would rescind East Brother Light Station's coverage under the Board's Mercury Watershed Permit, which would also no longer be

needed once discharge to land commences.
