**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR RESCISSION OF NPDES PERMIT
AND ISSUANCE OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

**East Brother Light Station, Inc., East Brother Island
117 Park Place, Point Richmond, CA 94801, Contra Costa County**

The above Discharger intends to cease discharging to surface water and begin land application of treated, filtered, and disinfected domestic wastewater, and has filed an application for waste discharge requirements for an on-site disposal area. Regional Water Board staff has prepared a tentative order rescinding an existing NPDES permit for surface water discharge and establishing waste discharge requirements for land application that include effluent limitations and special provisions in accordance with the California Water Quality Control Act.

The Regional Water Board intends to consider adopting the tentative order during a meeting to commence at the time and location as follows:

The deadline for comment is 5:00 p.m. on October 7 2010. Comments must be sent to the **attention of John H. Madigan**. Persons wishing to file written comments on or objections to the tentative permit or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline for the comments to be considered. No written comments will be accepted or responded to in writing if received after that deadline. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing on this matter. The Regional Water Board will hear oral testimony, but will not accept written comments after the deadline.

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Regional Water Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence delivered to the Regional Water Board.

The tentative permit, comments received, and related documents may be inspected and copied at the Regional Water Board office.
