SUBJECT: **Rodeo Sanitary District Water Pollution Control Facility and Collection System, Rodeo, Contra Costa County - Reissuance of NPDES Permit**

CHRONOLOGY: December 2006 – Permit reissued

DISCUSSION: The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) would reissue the NPDES permit for the Rodeo Sanitary District with updated discharge limits and provisions. The District discharges an average of 1.14 million gallons per day of secondary treated wastewater to San Pablo Bay through a deep water outfall. It serves about 8,900 persons in Rodeo and Tormey, which are unincorporated areas of western Contra Costa County.

Only the District submitted comments (Appendix B) on a tentative order distributed for public review. We made many of the changes requested and believe we have resolved all issues. The changes are described in the Response to Comments (Appendix C) and are reflected in the Revised Tentative Order.
