1995 - Updated Waste Discharge Requirements adopted

DISCUSSION: The Tentative Order for the West Winton Landfill (Appendix A)

would update its waste discharge requirements principally to reflect updated landfill regulations and require changes to its operations and

maintenance and self-monitoring plans. The Landfill is an

approximately 60-acre municipal landfill, located on the Hayward Regional Shoreline. Closed in 1976, the Landfill is currently in postclosure maintenance and monitoring and serves as a public park and

part of the Bay Trail.

We circulated a draft tentative order to Waste Management, the City of Hayward, and interested parties, and received no comments. Waste Management and the City have indicated agreement with the Tentative Order, and we expect this item to remain uncontested.
