Reissuance of General NPDES Permit

**CHRONOLOGY**: April 2007 – General Permit issued

**DISCUSSION:** The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) would reissue the regionwide

general permit to cover discharge or reuse of extracted brackish

groundwater, reverse osmosis concentrate from treatment of groundwater by reverse osmosis, and extracted and treated groundwater resulting from

structural dewatering.

We received written comments from three dischargers (Appendix B) on a

draft that was distributed for public review and made revisions as

appropriate. Most comments were editorial. The Revised Tentative Order reflects these changes. The most significant comment requested increasing the reporting levels for specific inorganic compounds. We disagree with this change as indicated in the Response to Comments (Appendix C).

We expect the Revised Tentative Order to remain uncontested.
