REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION
FOR
Santa Clara Valley Water District
Stream Maintenance Program**

The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board's staff has prepared a tentative Order for water quality certification and waste discharge requirements to the Santa Clara Valley Water District (SCVWD) to implement its Stream Maintenance Program (SMP) as specified in the SMP Manual. The tentative Order authorizes routine maintenance activities including vegetation management, sediment removal, bank stabilization, management of animal conflicts, minor maintenance, and canal maintenance within Guadalupe River, Coyote Creek, Lower Peninsula, and West Valley watersheds.

The deadline for comments on the Tentative Order has been extended to 5:00 p.m. on December 14, 2012. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Margarete Beth**. Persons wishing to file written comments on or objections to the Tentative Order or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Water Board intends to consider adopting the Tentative Order during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on February 13, 2013, in the Auditorium of the Elihu Harris State Building at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing. Pursuant to section 2050(c) of title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Water Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence.

All documents related to the Tentative Order may be inspected and copied at the Water Board office. The Tentative Order, SCVWD SMP Manual and associated attachments, and any additional information and developments on this matter are also available at www.waterboards.ca.gov/sanfranciscobay.
