Please submit any comments in writing by no later than **5:00 p.m.**, **January 12, 2012**, to the attention of Farhad Azimzadeh. We will not consider or include comments received after this date when preparing the package presented to the Regional Water Board for its consideration. We will post our response to comments on our website one week prior to the hearing.

Note the following proposed significant changes:

- Dischargers currently covered under the VOC General Permit (CAG912003) must seek coverage by filing a notice of intent under this new VOC and Fuel General Permit after CAG912003 expires in 2014. We plan to discontinue CAG912003 after its expiration.
- The Tentative Order includes a discharge limitation for residual chlorine from the VOC General Permit CAG912003 for those dischargers that use chlorine to treat extracted groundwater. Other limits remain the same as the current separate Fuel General Permit and VOC General Permit.
- The Tentative Order includes revised NOI and notice of termination forms.
