SUBJECT: **Dublin San Ramon Services District (DSRSD), Livermore-Amador Valley Water Management Agency, East Bay Dischargers Authority (EBDA), DSRSD Wastewater Treatment Plant and Associated Collection System, Dublin, Alameda County – Reissuance of NPDES Permit**

CHRONOLOGY: August 2006 – Permit Reissued

DISCUSSION: The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) would reissue DSRSD's permit for the discharge of treated wastewater from its treatment plant into the EBDA system for ultimate discharge to Central San Francisco Bay. This item is to be considered at the same time as item 7 for EBDA as well as item 9 for the City of Livermore. DSRSD's treatment plant is one of the six treatment plants that discharge through the EBDA outfall. Many of the requirements that would apply for EBDA would also apply in this permit. However, a separate permit is necessary because DSRSD is not a member of EBDA.

Since the tentative orders circulated for the City of Livermore, DSRSD, and EBDA are nearly identical, the comments received and our responses apply to all three items. Additionally, the attached response to comments includes responses that apply to just DSRSD's tentative order. All changes proposed are described in the Response to Comments (Appendix C) and reflected in the Revised Tentative Order.

We expect this item to be uncontested.
