The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, Prosecution Team and Ross Valley Sanitary District have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order. The proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order impose an administrative civil liability against the District in the amount of \$1,539,100 for sanitary sewer overflows that discharged to Corte Madera Creek and tributaries between 2008 and 2011.

Persons may comment on the proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order by submitting written comments addressed to the attention of Prosecution Team staff Claudia Villacorta at cvillacorta@waterboards.ca.gov or to the address shown below. Comments must be received by the Water Board's Prosecution Team no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 21, 2012.

The Executive Officer will adopt the order if no significant comments are received by the deadline above. If significant comments are received, a hearing before the Water Board may be scheduled.
