RESPONSE TO WRITTEN COMMENTS

On May 21, 2013, Tentative Order for
Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County, Tiburon, Marin County

The Regional Water Board received written comments from the Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County (District) on a tentative order distributed for public comment. This response to those comments summarizes the comment in *italics* (paraphrased for brevity) followed by a staff response. Revisions are shown with ~~strikethrough~~ for deletions and underline for additions. For the full content and context of each comment, refer to the comment letter.

District Comment

The District points out typographical errors. It requests changes to Title Page (Table 1, last line) and Provision IV.C.1.d (page 9) of the tentative order.

Response to District Comment

We agree and revised the title page (Table 1) as follows:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board have classified this discharge as a minor <u>major</u> discharge.	

We revised Provision IV.C.1.d (page 9) as follows:

- d. If the Discharger can demonstrate that toxicity exceeding the levels cited above is caused by ammonia and that the ammonia in the ~~discharger~~ discharge complies with ammonia effluent limits, then such toxicity does not constitute a violation of this effluent limitation.
