ITEM: 5A

SUBJECT: Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County, Sanitary District No. 5 Wastewater Treatment Plant and Wastewater Collection System, Tiburon, Marin County – Reissuance of NPDES Permit

CHRONOLOGY: July 2008 – Permit reissued

DISCUSSION: This Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) would reissue the NPDES permit for Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County. The District owns and operates a 0.98 million-gallon-per-day secondary treatment plant and its associated wastewater collection system serving about 8,400 people in Tiburon, Belvedere, and surrounding unincorporated areas. Treated wastewater is discharged to Raccoon Strait in Central San Francisco Bay through a deepwater outfall extending approximately 850 feet offshore.

The District submitted brief comments (Appendix B) on a draft permit distributed for review. We prepared a response to the comments (Appendix C). The Revised Tentative Order reflects minor revisions. We expect this item to remain uncontested.
