NOTICE OF PENDING ENFORCEMENT ACTION
NAPA VALLEY CAST STONE, LLC

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team issued a Complaint for Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) on April 11, 2013. The Complaint alleges that Napa Valley Cast Stone, LLC (Discharger) failed to implement best management practices as required under Water Code section 13385(a)(2) and in accordance with Water Quality Order No. 97-03-DWQ National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit No. CAS000001 for a property located at 1111 Green Valley Road in American Canyon, and it proposes that the Discharger pay \$5,200.

The Complaint and related documents, including the procedure for Water Board hearings (with deadlines for submitting comments), are available at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sanfranciscobay/public_notices/pending_enforcement.shtml. The Prosecution Team may amend and re-notice its Complaint in response to comments from the Discharger or the public.

The Water Board will hold a hearing on July 10, 2013, to consider adoption of the ACL and/or referral of the matter to the Attorney General, unless the Discharger waives its right to a hearing within 90 days. The 90-day hearing requirement may be waived to pay the penalty as proposed, extend deadlines, or pursue settlement and/or a supplemental environmental project.
