NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**TENTATIVE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER
FOR
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF MARIN COUNTY
(ALSO KNOWN AS “ROSS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT”)
SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM
IN MARIN COUNTY**

The Assistant Executive Officer has issued a tentative Cease and Desist Order (CDO) pursuant to Water Code section 13301, which if adopted by the Board would require that the Ross Valley Sanitary District cease and desist from discharging in violation of State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2006-0003-DWQ, “Statewide Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems.” The tentative CDO sets forth specific tasks to improve sewer system rehabilitation and financing.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the tentative CDO is 5:00 p.m. on April 25, 2013. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Michael Chee**. Persons wishing to file written comments on or objections to the tentative CDO or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board intends to consider adopting the tentative CDO during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **May 8, 2013**, in the Auditorium of the Elihu Harris State Building at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing.

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Board’s action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence.

All documents related to the tentative CDO may be inspected and copied at the Board office. The tentative CDO and any additional information and developments on this matter are also available at www.waterboards.ca.gov/sanfranciscobay.
