SUBJECT: Pacific Gas & Electric Company, Shell Pond, Bay Point, Contra Costa County -

Rescission of NPDES Permit

CHRONOLOGY: February 2006 - Permit reissued

**DISCUSSION:** This Tentative Order (Appendix A) would rescind the NPDES permit for the Pacific

Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) Shell Pond located at Bay Point in Contra Costa County. The facility is a former waste pond once owned by Shell, and the permitted discharge consisted of water pumped from a slough into the pond and returned to the slough. The water was used to maintain salinity levels to enhance aquatic habitat in the pond until approval of final remediation measures. PG&E continues to work to clean up the pond under California Department of Toxic Substances Control supervision. PG&E ceased discharge and filled the pond's discharge canal in November 2011. Therefore,

the NPDES permit can be rescinded.

We received no written comments on the Tentative Order and expect this item to

remain uncontested.
