NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER  
in the matter of  
OG PROPERTY OWNER, LLC  
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and OG Property Owner, LLC (Discharger) have entered into a Settlement Agreement that proposes an assessment of \$449,000 in administrative civil liability against the Discharger. The proposed liability is for violation of section V.A.2 Narrative Effluent Limitations of the NPDES General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction and Land Disturbance Activities, Order No. 2009-0009-DWQ, by discharging an estimated 379,000 gallons of storm water polluted by sediments to San Pablo Creek, Orinda, Contra Costa County on December 15, 2014.
