Board staff has prepared draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits for the above dischargers in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. The draft permits regulate treated wastewater discharges to Lower San Francisco Bay.

The deadline for receipt of comment on these draft permits is 5:00 p.m. on April 3, 2017. Comments must be sent to the **attention of James Parrish**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permits during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **May 10, 2017**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party that challenges the Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
