This letter transmits Division of Drinking Water's (DDW) acceptance for the City and County of San Francisco's Non-Potable Water Program Engineering Report (Engineering Report) dated August 2017. The Engineering Report was submitted to address DDW comment letter dated July 31, 2017.

The City and County of San Francisco has a Non-potable Water Program that establishes permitting requirements for the collection, treatment, and use of alternate water sources (graywater, rainwater, stormwater, foundation water, black water) for new commercial, multi family, and mixed-use developments in San Francisco. San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) submitted the Engineering Report and is the agency responsible for the administration and oversight of the Non-potable Water Program.

Revisions and updates to the Engineering Report (including its appendices) must be provided to DDW to demonstrate applicable operations and management programs in place. Any updates or changes to the Engineering Report must also be made in any application documents and submitted to the Regional Water Quality Control Board (i.e. any technical support documents and Report of Waste Discharge documents).
