NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT

Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District 450 Ryder Street, Vallejo, Solano County

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The District owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant that provides secondary treatment of domestic and commercial wastewater from the City of Vallejo, the former Mare Island Naval Facility, and an adjacent unincorporated area for a total service population of approximately 120,000. The Plant's average dry weather design treatment capacity is 15.5 million gallons per day; it discharges treated, disinfected wastewater through two deep-water outfalls to Mare Island Strait and Carquinez Strait.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is 5:00 p.m. on August 21, 2017. Comments must be sent to the attention of John H Madigan. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **September 13, 2017**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
