NOTICE OF PENDING ENFORCEMENT ACTION
ISAIAS MUNOZ

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team issued a Complaint for Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) on December 14, 2017. The Complaint alleges that Isaias Munoz (Operator) is responsible for operating an industrial facility without a stormwater discharge permit at Munoz Granite, 1260 Yard Court, Suite E, San Jose, and proposes that the Operator pay \$14,000, the mandatory minimum penalty required under California Water Code section 13399.33.

The Prosecution Team may amend and re-notice its Complaint in response to comments from the Operator or the public.

The Water Board will hold a hearing on March 14, 2018, to consider adoption of the ACL and/or referral of the matter to the Attorney General, unless the Operator waives his right to a hearing within 90 days. The 90-day hearing requirement may be waived to pay the penalty as proposed or extend deadlines.
