Subject: Transmittal of Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for Administrative Civil Liability Order No. R2-2018-1001 for Equilon Enterprises LLC, dba Shell Oil Products US, Shell Martinez Refinery, Contra Costa County

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Enclosed is Order No. R2-2018-1001, which imposes an administrative civil liability in the amount of **\$86,000** to Shell for discharges to waters of the United States in violation of NPDES permit effluent limits. Shell is required to pay **\$43,000** of the total liability by **April 16, 2018**. Shell is also required to pay the remaining **\$43,000** for use towards the Supplemental Environmental Project Fund for the San Francisco Bay Regional Monitoring Program by **April 16, 2018**.

Payment

The payment shall be remitted by check in the amount of **\$43,000** to the "State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account" as set forth in the Order. We will endeavor to send an invoice for payment in advance of the payment due date. However, any failure by us to send an invoice does not absolve Shell of its obligation to comply with the Order or provide payment by the above due date.

If the payment deadline set forth herein is not met, the Board's prosecution staff may allow a 15-day period to cure any non-payment. Following the 15th day of non-payment, prosecution staff may enforce the terms of the Order and seek the immediate payment of the remaining balance. Alternatively, the Board's Assistant Executive Officer may refer the matter to the California Attorney General's Office to obtain payment in compliance with the terms of the Order or take other appropriate actions.
