**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING  
FOR  
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**City and County of San Francisco  
San Francisco International Airport, Mel Leong Treatment Plant  
Bldg. 924 Clearwater Drive, San Francisco, San Mateo County  
and  
North Bayside System Unit  
195 Belle Air Road, South San Francisco, San Mateo County**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The City and County of San Francisco owns and operates the airport and its sanitary and industrial wastewater treatment plants, which collectively treat about 1.1 million gallons of wastewater per day for discharge to San Francisco Bay through the North Bayside System Unit's submerged diffuser located approximately 5,300 feet offshore from Point San Bruno, at a depth of about 20 feet.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is **5:00 p.m. on September 5, 2018**. Comments must be sent to the attention of **Patrick Karinja**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at **9:00 a.m. on October 10, 2018**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
