**SUBJECT:** Novato Sanitary District, Novato Sanitary District

Wastewater Treatment Plant and Collection System, Novato, Marin County – Reissuance of NPDES Permit

CHRONOLOGY: July 2015 – Permit reissued

**DISCUSSION:** This Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) would reissue the

NPDES permit for the Novato Sanitary District (District) Wastewater Treatment Plant. The plant provides secondary treatment of domestic and non-domestic wastewater from the City of Novato and adjacent unincorporated Marin County, serving a population of about 60,000. The plant treats about 5.0 million gallons per day of wastewater for discharge to San Pablo Bay.

The Revised Tentative Order would remove the Regional Water Board's dry season discharge prohibition. This change would enable the Marin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District to restore wetlands on pasturelands that the District currently irrigates with its effluent during the dry season. These wetlands would create continuous tidal habitat around San Pablo Bay that promote climate change resiliency and improve flood and sediment conveyance along Novato Creek. The Revised Tentative Order would also continue to allow the District to relocate its discharge outfall about 1.2 miles inland to support a new marsh south of Bel Marin Keys as part of a State Coastal Conservancy wetland restoration project; this marsh would be a part of San Pablo Bay and would rely on the District's effluent as a freshwater source.

We received comments from the District (Appendix B) on a draft permit distributed for public review. We prepared a response to those comments (Appendix C) that explain changes reflected in the Revised Tentative Order. The most significant change was to clarify the District's level of treatment. We also made editorial changes in Fact Sheet section VIII.C (Public Participation) to reflect that the public hearing was held virtually. We expect this item to be uncontested.
