NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER in the matter of

SONOMA VALLEY COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT UNAUTHORIZED DISCHARGE OF PARTIALLY-TREATED WASTEWATER SONOMA, SONOMA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District (Discharger) have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order (proposed settlement order). The proposed settlement order imposes an administrative civil liability against the Discharger in the amount of \$427,600 for an alleged unauthorized discharge of partially-treated wastewater to waters of the United States in violation of Water Code section 13376 and Clean Water Act section 301.

The proposed settlement would allow \$213,800 to be suspended pending completion of an Enhanced Compliance Action project to allow the Discharger to improve the performance of its collection system beyond those actions required by law and its NPDES permit.
