RESPONSE TO WRITTEN COMMENT

On the Tentative Order for Livermore-Amador Valley Water Management Agency Export and Storage Facilities Intermittent Wet Weather Discharge

The Regional Water Board received a written comment from the Livermore-Amador Valley Water Management Agency (LAVWMA) on a tentative order distributed for public comment. Comment: LAVWMA requests we modify the description for planned changes at the San Leandro Sample Station. While the District intends for the upgrades to eliminate the need to send personnel to the sample station during extreme wet weather, it acknowledges that this may be infeasible.

Response

We agree and revised Fact Sheet section 2.6 as follows:

Planned Changes. During this Order term, the Discharger plans to upgrade the San Leandro Sample Station (Monitoring Location M-001) to allow remote operation. This will eliminate reduce the need to send personnel to the sample station during extreme wet weather.
