NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER
in the matter of

**LENNAR HOMES OF CALIFORNIA, INC.
UNAUTHORIZED DISCHARGE OF DOMESTIC SEWAGE TO CHABOT CANAL
DUBLIN, ALAMEDA COUNTY**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and Lennar Homes of California, Inc. (Discharger) have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order (proposed settlement order). The proposed settlement order imposes an administrative civil liability against the Discharger in the amount of \$212,300 for alleged discharges of unauthorized domestic sewage to waters of the United States.

The proposed liability is based on allegations that the Discharger violated California Water Code section 13376, Clean Water Act section 301, and Basin Plan Discharge Prohibition 15.

The proposed settlement order would allow \$106,150 to be suspended pending completion of a supplemental environmental project to fund the San Francisco Bay Regional Monitoring Program, specifically for use toward the "Characterizing Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) and Chlorinated Paraffins in San Francisco Bay Sediment" project.
