NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT REGARDING RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR SITE CLEANUP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE OFFSHORE PROPERTY BETWEEN PIER 39 AND PIER 43½ IN SAN FRANCISCO

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Board Resolution (Resolution) adopting the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for Site Cleanup Requirements for the Pier 39 to 43½ Sediment Site.

The Resolution would approve and adopt the MND for cleanup of the Pier 39 43½ Sediment Site. The Resolution summarizes: site investigations; the intention to adopt Site Cleanup Requirements; that the Water Board is the lead agency; and that the Initial Study identified potential significant environmental effects associated with implementing planned remediation activities but that these effects will be avoided or will result in less than significant impacts with the incorporation of mitigation measures.
