NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

ON

UPDATED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR WEST CONTRA COSTA SANITARY LANDFILL LOCATED AT THE WEST END OF PARR BOULEVARD – RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order (Order) for updating Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order R2-2006-0008 for West County Landfill, Inc., and West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill, Inc.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN THAT the Water Board will hold a public hearing to consider adopting the Order at a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **March 9, 2022**. An agenda for the Board meeting will be available ten days before the meeting at:

<u>https://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sanfranciscobay/board_info/agenda.html.</u> The agenda will contain information on the meeting and how to participate. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

The Order would update the current Waste Discharge Requirements for the closed Class II landfill. The updated Order would fulfil six primary objectives: to reflect the current closed status of the landfill; to reflect the continued, authorized and regulated use of the landfill's upper deck for an organic material processing and composting operation; to require the dischargers to continue to monitor and manage leachate elevations within the landfill; to clarify beneficial uses of adjacent waters; to require a time schedule of actions to prevent contaminated stormwater runoff from entering anddegrading Pond B; and to update the landfill's Self-Monitoring Program.
