**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**City of Calistoga
Calistoga City Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant and its Associated Collection
System
1100 Dunaweal Lane, Calistoga**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The City of Calistoga owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant that treats about 0.6 million gallons per day of domestic, commercial, and industrial wastewater. Most of the plant's treated wastewater is used for golf course and landscape irrigation. During wet weather, the City discharges secondary and tertiary treated wastewater to the Napa River when flows exceed its recycled water demand.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is **5:00 p.m. on February 18, 2022**. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Kerry O'Connor**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **March 9, 2022**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
