NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER
in the matter of

**MISSION VALLEY ROCK CO., LLC
UNAUTHORIZED DISCHARGE OF 41,000 GALLONS OF SEDIMENT-LADEN
PROCESS WASTEWATER TO ALAMEDA CREEK
SUNOL, ALAMEDA COUNTY**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and Mission Valley Rock Co., LLC (Discharger) have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order (proposed settlement order). The proposed settlement order imposes an administrative civil liability against the Discharger in the amount of \$368,940 for alleged discharges of unauthorized sediment-laden process wastewater to waters of the United States.

The proposed liability is based on allegations that the Discharger violated Prohibition III.A of Order R2-2020-0028 (NPDES Permit CAG982001).

The proposed settlement order would allow \$184,470 to be suspended pending completion of a supplemental environmental project to fund the San Francisco Bay Regional Monitoring Program, specifically for use toward the "High-Speed Mapping of Water Quality Parameters on the Eastern Shoal of South San Francisco Bay" project.
