NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER  
in the matter of

**CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO  
EFFLUENT LIMITATION VIOLATIONS AT THE SOUTHEAST AND  
OCEANSIDE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and the City and County of San Francisco have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order. The proposal would impose an administrative civil liability against San Francisco in the amount of \$238,300 for alleged discharges of partially treated wastewater exceeding effluent limitations to waters of the United States.

The proposal would allow \$119,150 to be suspended pending completion of a supplemental environmental project to fund the San Francisco Estuary Institute, specifically for use toward the “Temporal Variability in Sediment Delivery to a North and Central San Francisco Bay Salt Marsh” project.
