**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board has prepared a Tentative Order to rescind the Risk Management and Mitigation Requirements listed in Order No. R2-2022-0009. The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is currently overseeing further investigation and remediation of mercury in indoor air, soil gas, and soil under Docket no. HAS-FY22/23-026026. The Regional Water Board has retained the oversight of the groundwater contamination, which is currently being overseen under Order No. 95-233.
