**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board has prepared a Tentative Order to amend Site Cleanup Requirements Order No. R2-2007-0009. Proposed amendments include requiring additional cleanup based on the past 15 years of data and analyses from investigations and monitoring activities and updating cleanup levels for soil, groundwater, soil vapor, and indoor air based on current information about risk.
