PROPOSED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR KB HOME – SOUTH BAY, INC., COMMUNICATIONS HILL 2, PHASES 3 & 4 AND INDUSTRIAL PROJECT IN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE IN SANTA CLARA COUNTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order for issuing Waste Discharge Requirements for the KB Home – South Bay, Inc., Communications Hill 2, Phases 3 & 4 and Industrial Project in the City of San Jose in Santa Clara County.

The Tentative Order would authorize the placement of fill in waters of the state for the construction of a mixed-use residential and industrial development on 172 acres of Communications Hill.
