NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT

Browning-Ferris Industries of California, Inc. Corinda Los Trancos (Ox Mountain) Landfill 12310 San Mateo Road, Half Moon Bay, San Mateo County

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System general permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The discharger owns the Corinda Los Trancos Landfill, a disposal site for municipal, non-hazardous waste. The draft permit addresses naturally occurring groundwater that has infiltrated into the landfill or contacted the landfill system. The discharger extracts and treats this groundwater to remove pollutants obtained from the landfill before discharging it to Corinda Los Trancos Creek, a tributary of Pilarcitos Creek. The draft permit also addresses the facility's stormwater discharges.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft order is **5:00 p.m. on February 12, 2024**. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Marcos De la Cruz**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft order during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **March 13, 2024**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
