City of San Leandro, Municipal Regional Stormwater Permit Permittee, San Leandro, Alameda County – Adoption of Cease and Desist Order

DISCUSSION

This supplemental for Item 7B was prepared by the Prosecution Team.

This document describes changes to the Revised Tentative Cease and Desist Order recommended by the Prosecution Team. These changes are based on information provided by the City of San Leandro (City) on December 2, 2025. Finding 13 of the Revised Tentative Cease and Desist Order currently states the Permittee has secured a bid to install additional inlet-based full trash capture devices. However, due to delays caused by the federal government shutdown, the City only recently received final confirmation that it was awarded a U.S. EPA grant, and has not yet secured bids. This change does not impact the City's proposed compliance schedule, including the small inlet-based device installation deadline of August 31, 2026.

Additions are shown by <u>underlined</u> text, and deletions are shown by <u>strikethrough</u> text. We propose Finding 13 of the Revised Tentative Order read as follows:

The Permittee has secured a bid been awarded a U.S. EPA Community Grant for the installation of 146 small inlet-based full trash capture devices that are scheduled for installation by August 31, 2026, and will treat approximately 675 acres of moderate and high trash generation area. Once installed, these devices will contribute an additional 8.5 percent toward the 100 percent reduction requirement.
