## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON TENTATIVE ORDER FOR WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

Old Pleasanton Landfill, Pleasanton, Alameda County

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board has prepared a Tentative Order prescribing Waste Discharge Requirements at the Old Pleasanton Landfill. The Pleasanton solid waste disposal site is a private landfill located at 2512 Vineyard Avenue. No waste has been disposed of at the Landfill since its closure in 1976. The Tentative Order would update the landfill's monitoring requirements and require evaluation of the ongoing Corrective Action Program.
