**NOTICE OF NEW PUBLIC HEARING DATE
FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Lehigh Southwest Cement Company, Permanente Plant
24001 Stevens Creek Blvd., Cupertino, Santa Clara County**

Regional Water Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit (draft permit) for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. The draft permit was posted for public comment on July 24, 2025, with a comment deadline of August 25, 2025. The Regional Water Board will respond to comments received as of that deadline. **The comment period remains closed.**

The Regional Water Board hearing to consider adopting the draft permit was originally scheduled for October 8, 2025. The hearing was delayed, then postponed pending appeal of the State appeals court decision on the State's toxicity policy (*Camarillo Sanitary District et al. v. State Water Resources Control Board*, case number F087362).

The Regional Water Board will now consider adopting the draft permit on **June 10, 2026**. The meeting will begin at **9:00 a.m.** Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
