Martinez Renewable Fuels Facility, Martinez – Adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements

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DISCUSSION:

The Tentative Order (Appendix A) would update the waste discharge requirements for the Martinez Renewable Fuels Facility located at 150 Solano Way in Martinez, California. Adoption of the Tentative Order is dependent on adoption of the tentative resolution to adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Waste Management Restoration Project (Agenda Item 7A).

The Tentative Order would terminate the previous waste discharge requirements. The waste discharge requirements contained in the Tentative Order are being updated to accomplish the following:

- Update Facility ownership and Facility name information
- Update the requirements for the closure and continued maintenance and monitoring of specified waste management units
- Update requirements for continued maintenance and monitoring of active Class II surface impoundments
- Update requirements for stormwater impoundments
- Require a vulnerability assessment and long-term flood protection plan to address sea level rise and groundwater rise
- Update the Self-Monitoring Program

We did not receive comments on the Tentative Order circulated for public review. We expect this item to remain uncontested.
