Findings Summary

- Very high support for NMS process
- Very little awareness of the NMS document
- > Inclusion is preferred over speed
- Strong belief that NMS can and should be different and provide a better model

Findings Summary

- Geographic distinctions between Delta and Bay are arbitrary
- Strong support for Delta and Bay representatives on the SC
- > High support for general proposed structure
- Strong support for a solid decision-making process on technical issues
- Strong concern about "who does the work"

Governance Recommendations


- > Finalize initial SC list
- > Invitations to join SC
- > Membership in SC
- Prepare a draft Charter document decision-making protocols, proposed membership, etc.

Technical Recommendations

- Clarify roles responsibilities, assignments
- Refine specific roles of Technical Team, Technical Stakeholders, and Peer Reviewers (include in Charter)
- Need to do a better job explaining the NMS technical approach
- Clarify SC interaction with Technical Team
- Clarify options for Peer Review structure and compensation
