RESOLUTION NO. 70-19

URGING ACTIONS BY SAN FRANCISCO BAY CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO WATER QUALITY CONTROL

WHEREAS

Section 66632(e) of the California Government Code provides that:

"(e) Upon receipt of an application for a permit the Commission shall transmit a copy thereof to the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board. Within 60 days the Board shall file a report with the Commission indicating the effect of the proposed project on water quality within the Bay."

This reporting requirement indicates the desirability for the Regional Board to enunciate a policy position relative to water quality considerations that are expected to be common to most permit applications.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

This Regional Board urges the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission to:

1. Require that the waste resulting from projects which come to the Commission for permits be connected to existing community sewerage systems.
2. Disapprove or temporarily withhold approval of any project which would cause added waste loading on a community sewerage system that is not meeting waste discharge requirements of the Regional Board if the Board has:
  - a. Issued a cease and desist order restricting inflow into the system or
  - b. Has stated its intent to consider such restriction within 90 days from the date of the permit application.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, HEREIN REFERRED TO AS THE REGIONAL BOARD, AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME, HEREIN REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, WITH REGARD TO SURVEILLANCE OF OCEAN WATERS.

- I. WHEREAS, this Regional Board has no ocean-going vessels or other means of carrying out surveillance of ocean waters within its jurisdiction and depends on the facilities of other agencies for this purpose; and
- II. WHEREAS, the Department has several ocean-going vessels which regularly patrol the ocean area under the Regional Board's jurisdiction; and
- III. WHEREAS, both the Regional Board and the Department have certain responsibilities established by law involving water quality; and
- IV. WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the Regional Board and the Department cooperate in carrying out their respective duties; now
- V. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Regional Board and the Department mutually understand and agree to the following:
  - A. The Department will notify the Regional Board of any suspected violations of the latter's requirements for ocean waste disposal which come to its attention in the course of its patrol work, etc.,
  - B. The Department may notify the waste discharger of any suspected violations of the Regional Board's requirements which come to its attention and shall report them to the Regional Board's office so that the Board can take proper action. Notwithstanding, however, the Department maintains the right to proceed independently at any time with enforcement of the provisions of the Fish and Game Code.
  - C. That the Regional Board will, so far as practical, provide the Department with advance information on the time and place of ocean waste disposal operations under Regional Board requirements.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (Contd.)

D. No financial obligations are assumed by either party to this agreement for services rendered to the other party nor is any liability assumed by either party for the acts of the other party.
