Order R8-2026-0049

Rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements
for
All Metals Processing of Orange County, Inc.

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (hereinafter Santa Ana Water Board), finds that:

1. The Order listed in Attachment "A" (Order) was issued by the Santa Ana Water Board to the discharger described therein. Attachment "A" is hereby made a part of this order. The Order for the discharger listed in Attachment "A" is hereby rescinded as the discharge authorized under the Order has ceased.
2. The discharge authorized under the Order has ceased. As such, this action will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. Further, there is no possibility that this action may have a significant effect on the environment. Accordingly, this action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3), Chapter 3, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
3. The Santa Ana Water Board has notified the discharger and interested persons of its intent to rescind the Order for the discharger listed in Attachment "A" and has provided them with an opportunity to submit written comments and recommendations.
4. The Santa Ana Water Board, in a public meeting held on October 23, 2026, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of the Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order previously adopted by the Santa Ana Water Board, R8-2025-0013, shall be rescinded, as provided in Attachment "A", except for enforcement purposes for violations that occurred while the Order was in effect.
