The Santa Ana Water Board will consider the adoption of waste discharge requirements authorizing the discharge of waste at the California Street Landfill, which is an active Class III municipal solid waste landfill in the City of Redlands. The order updates and replaces existing waste discharge requirements for the facility and prescribes discharge specifications, waste acceptance criteria, and monitoring and reporting requirements, consistent with the current federal and state laws and regulations.

The Santa Ana Water Board will consider adoption of an amendment to Waste Discharge Requirements Order R8-2018-0074 for the discharge of chemical amendments into the subsurface at the Former Lockheed Martin Beaumont Site 2, Laborde Canyon facility to promote in-situ groundwater remediation of perchlorate and potentially volatile organic compounds within the biobarrier treatment zone.
