# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES OF WASTE FROM INERT WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES WITHIN THE SANTA ANA REGION

### **TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2023-0018**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Order R8-2023-0018 (Tentative Order), which will replace existing Order R8-2019-0008 to serve as General Waste Discharge Requirements for discharges of waste from Inert Waste Disposal Facilities (IWDFs) located within the Santa Ana Region. The Tentative Order limits the types of waste that may be discharged at IWDFs to a subset of inert wastes and requires procedures to prevent the disposal of any wastes prohibited by the Tentative Order or that may cause pollution of water resources. The Tentative Order also contains requirements to ensure adequate cover maintenance, drainage, and erosion control at IWDFs as well as proper closure of enrolled facilities.

The Santa Ana Water Board intends to consider adopting the Tentative Order during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled Santa Ana Water Board meeting as follows:

The public may participate either in person at the physical meeting location or virtually via the Zoom meeting platform. For those who do not intend to actively participate, the meeting will be livestreamed via <a href="Cal-Span">Cal-Span</a>.

Interested persons may attend and express their views orally on this matter at the public hearing. Oral statements should be brief to allow all interested persons time to be heard. Such comments will generally be limited to three minutes, though the Board Chair may grant additional time on a case-by-case basis.

## **EX PARTE COMMUNICATIONS**

Ex parte communications are allowed subject to the disclosure requirements of Water Code section 13287. Ex parte communications are prohibited for a period beginning 14 days before the Board meeting at which the Tentative Order is scheduled for Board action. For communications concerning any issue in this proceeding, ex parte communications are prohibited starting on **April 21, 2023**. If the Santa Ana Water Board does not take action on May 5, 2023, the ex parte prohibition will remain in place until the Santa Ana Water Board, the Chair, or the Executive Officer directs otherwise. Once lifted, the prohibition on ex parte communications may be reinstated until 14 days before the day of the Board meeting to which the decision is continued. The Santa Ana Water Board will provide notice if the prohibition is lifted and/or reinstated.
